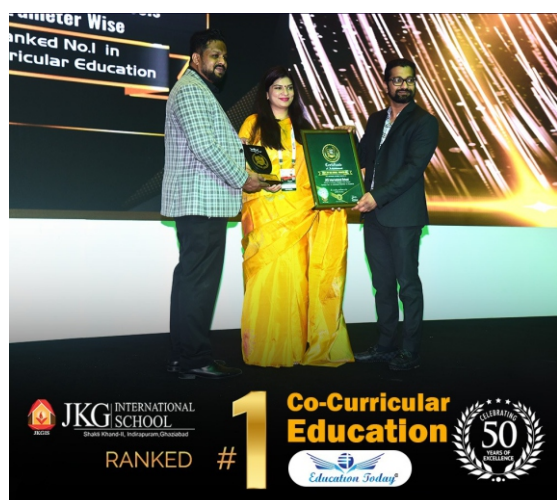
### INDIA K-12 Award

A career counselling workshop was organized for grade 10 on 6 July'22.

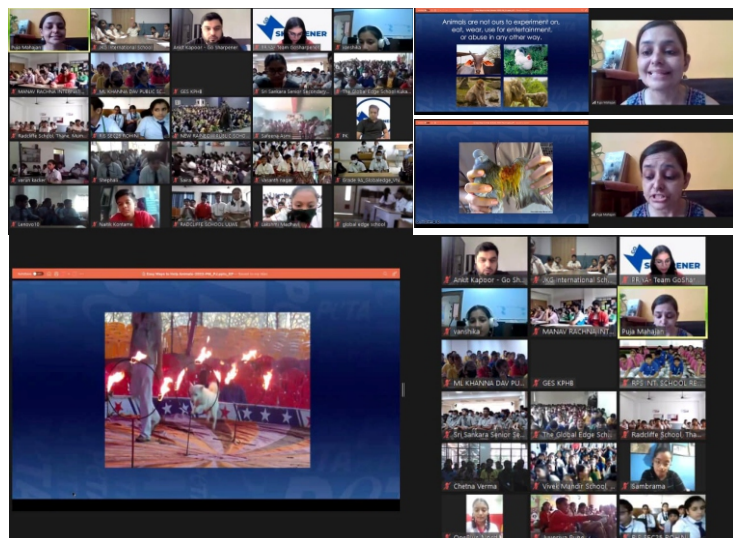

## Career Planning Workshop



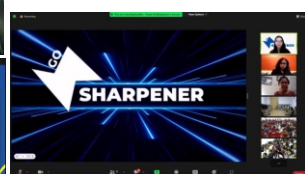
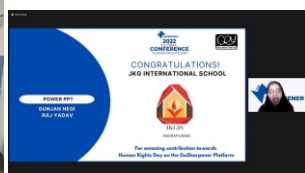
Career planning plays a pivotal role in shaping the future growth and development of students.

It was indeed both learning and leisure at one time.

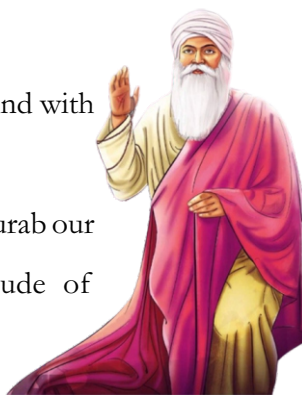

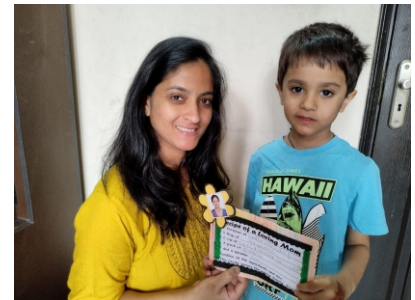




# Mother's Day

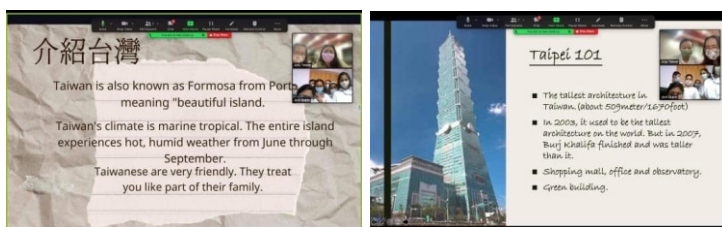
## Cultural Exchange program with Taiwan

On 26 April, Jkgians ardently participated in a cultural exchange programme with Jianguui Junior High School Taiwan.

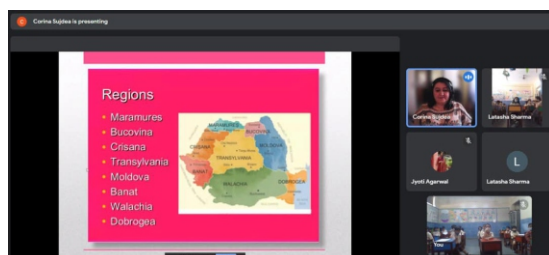
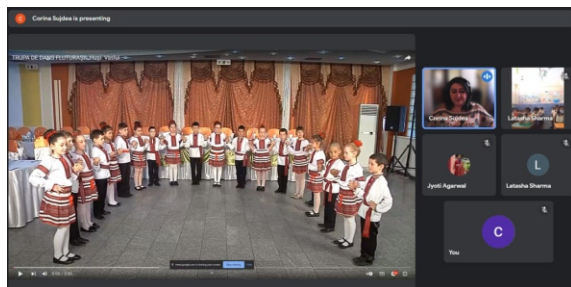

## Janmashtami Celebration with Greece & Nepal

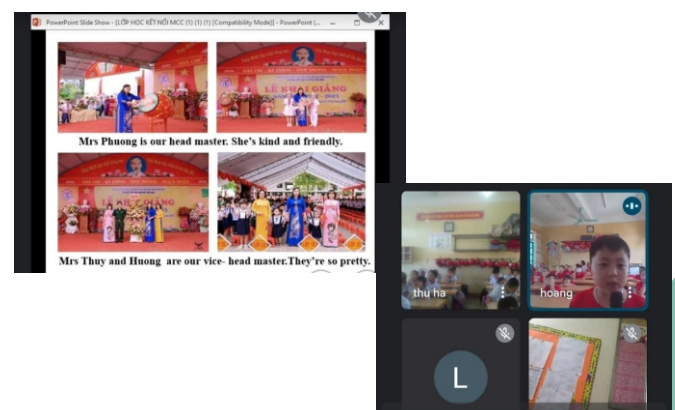


JKG International School has always been celebrating multiple events and festivals with many schools overseas which not only fosters global learning but also equip our young learners with super abundance skills.

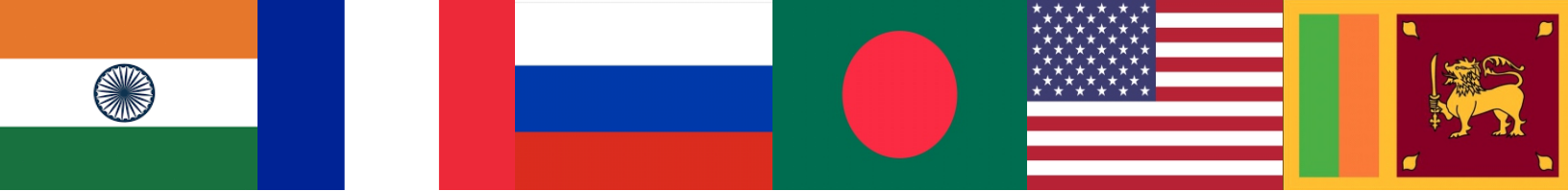

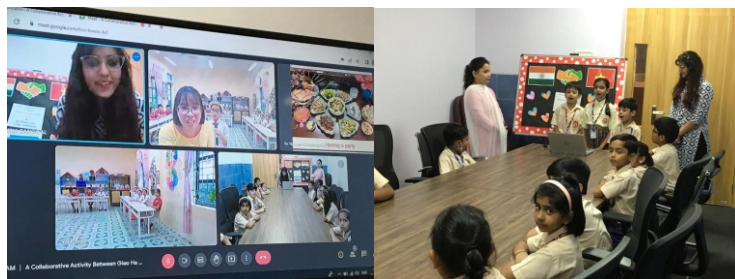


# Our Global Collaborations
