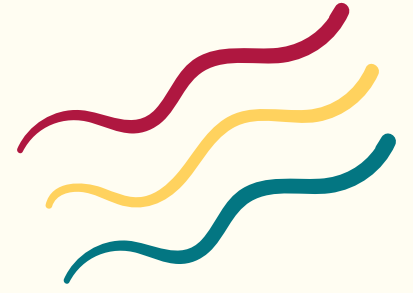

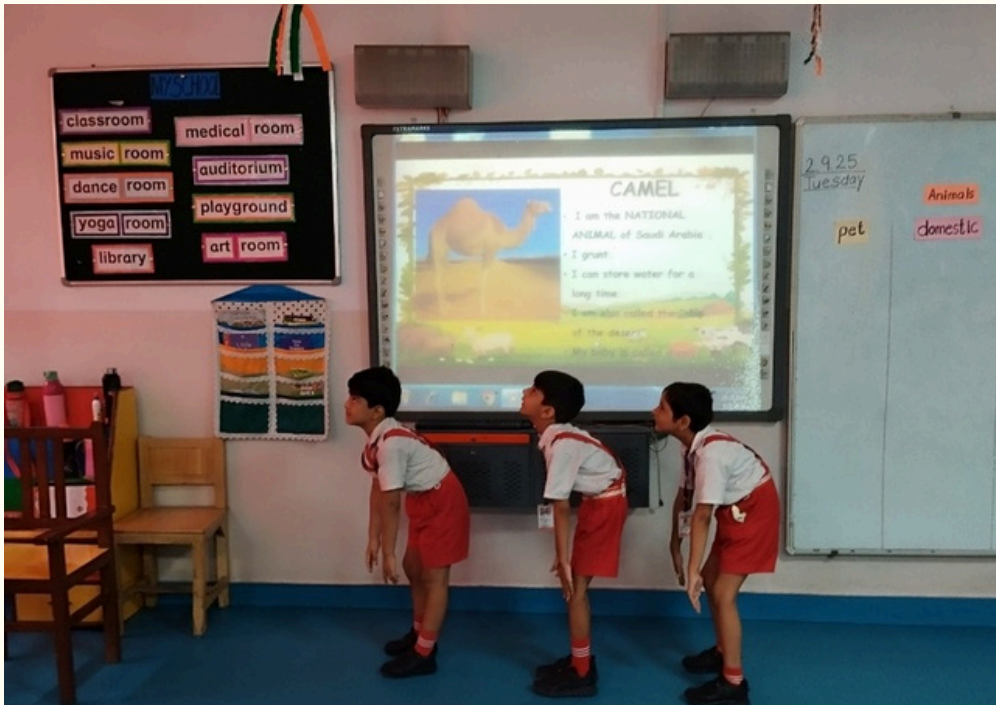


# ANIMAL ALLIES

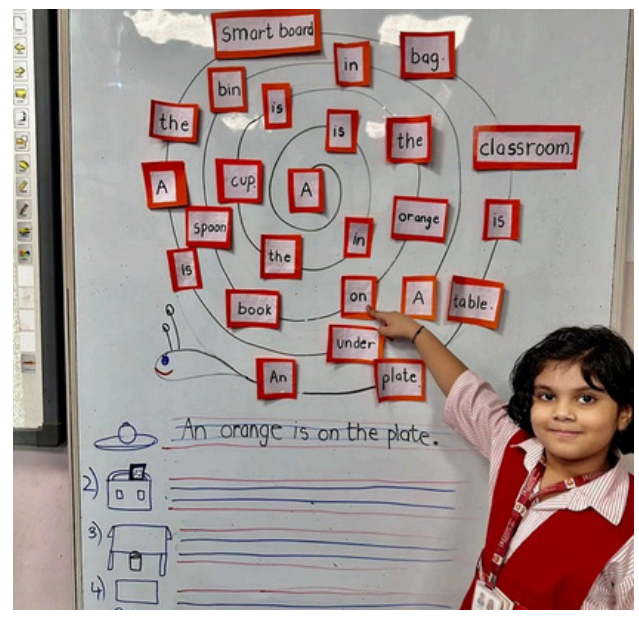
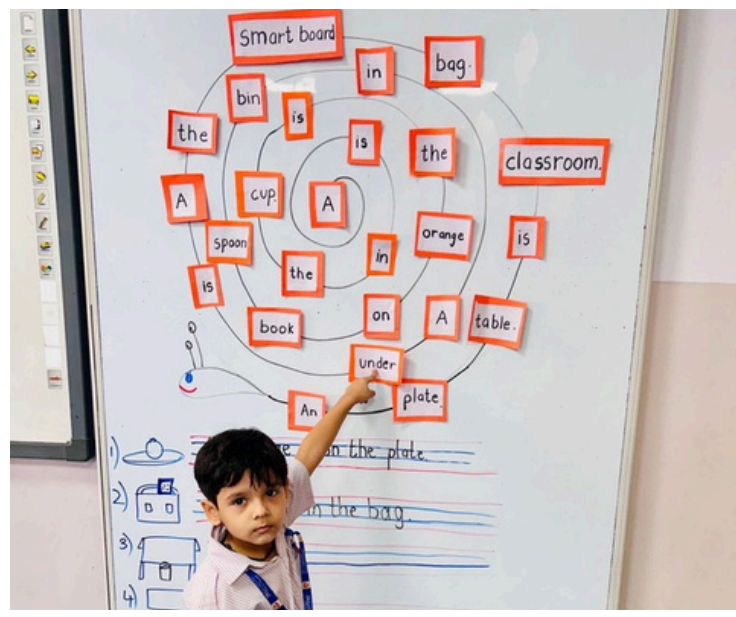
# Elmer... The Elephant (Story Telling Session)

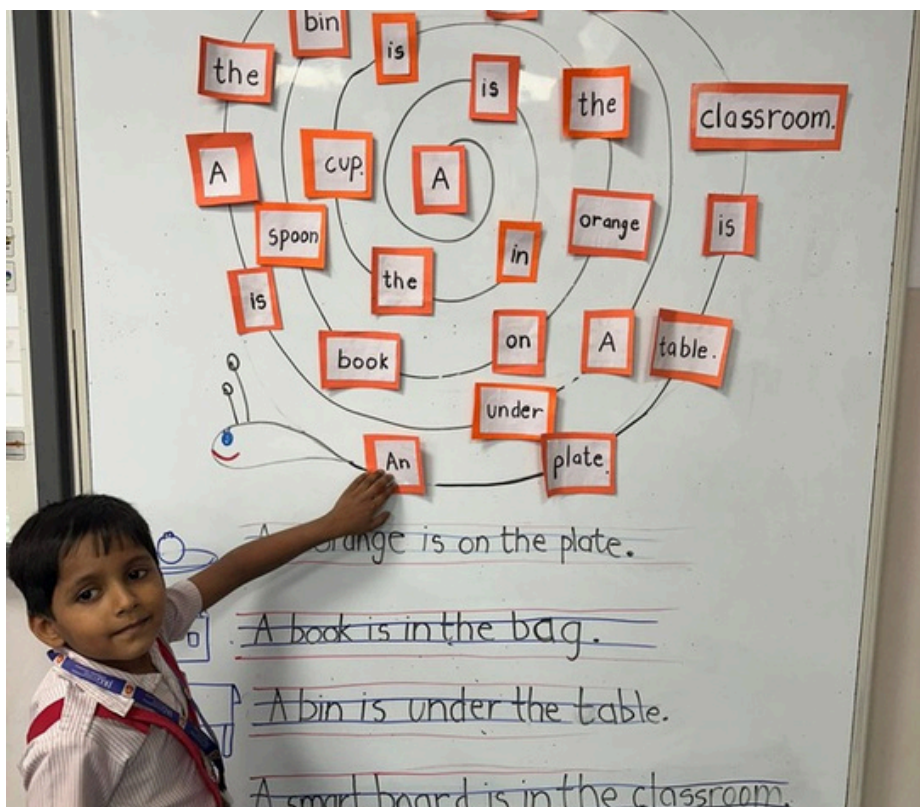
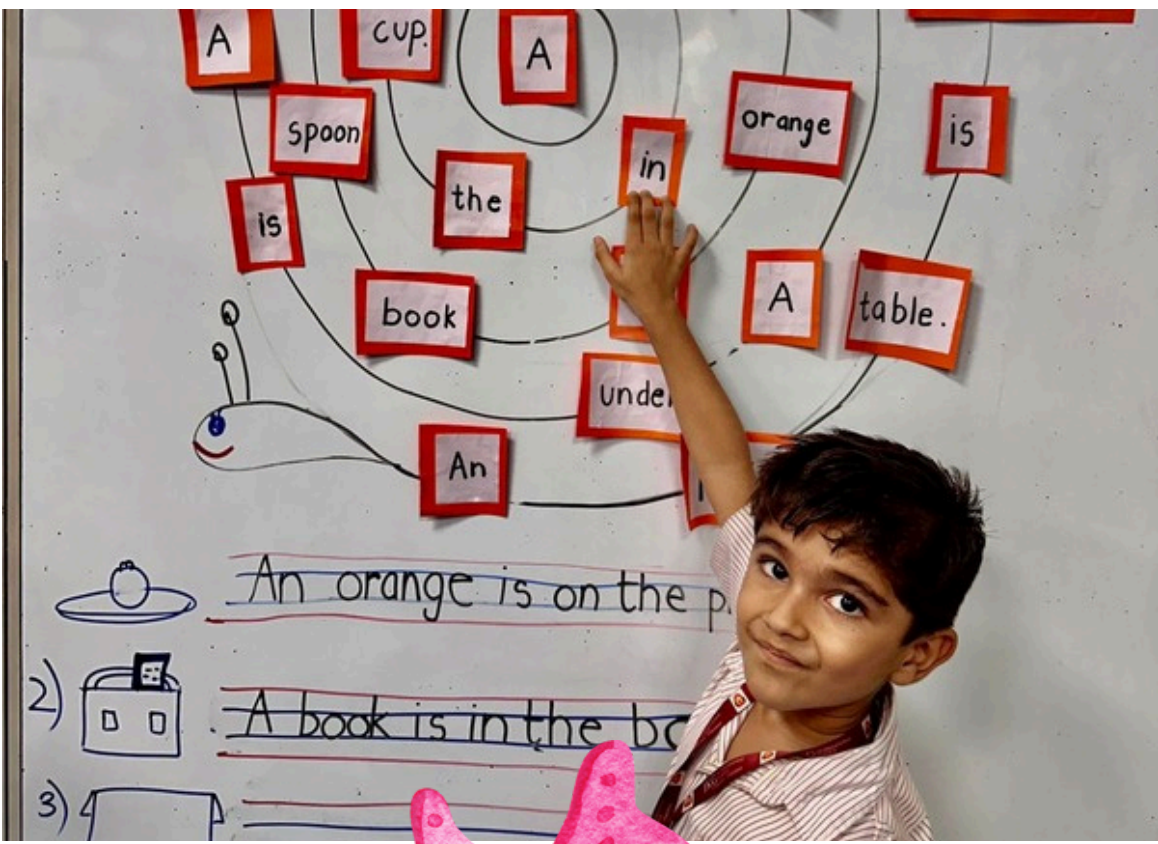


# Activity Corner: Where Learning Meets Fun

# Skip Counting through Number Line

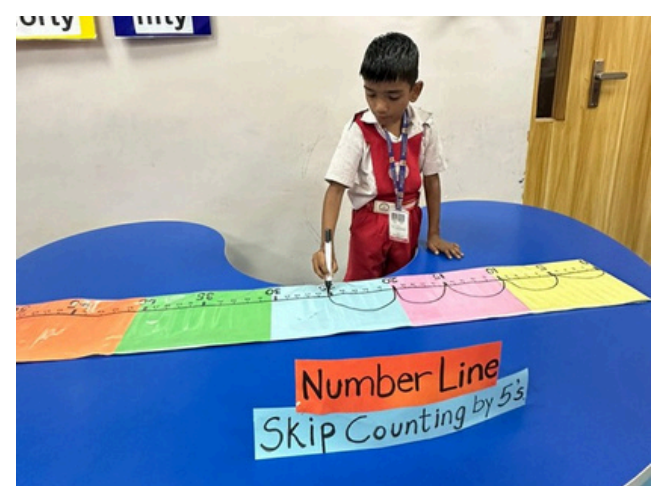
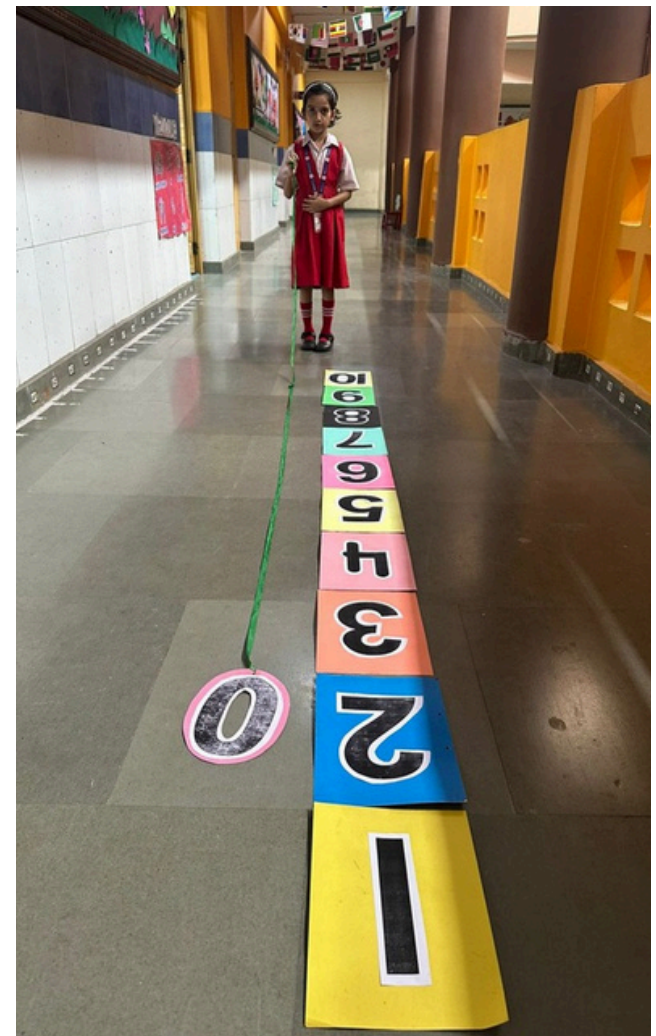


## skip counting 2's, 5's and 10's activity

Our enthusiastic learners of grade UKG explored Action Words (Verbs) - the words that tell us what we do!

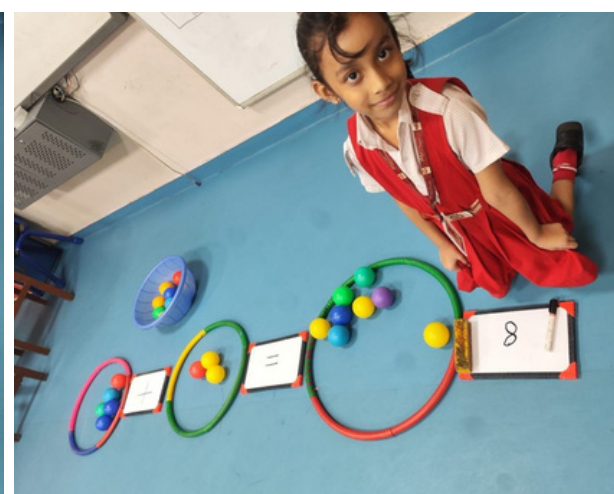
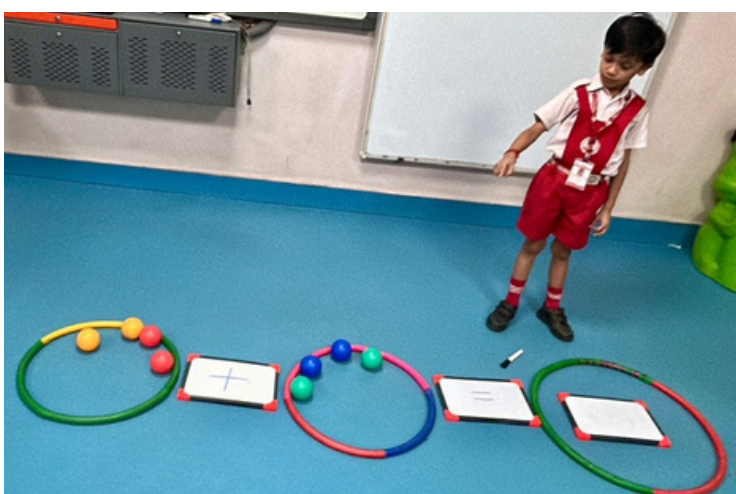
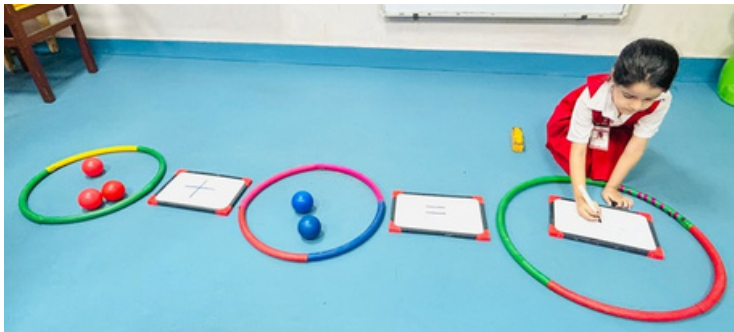
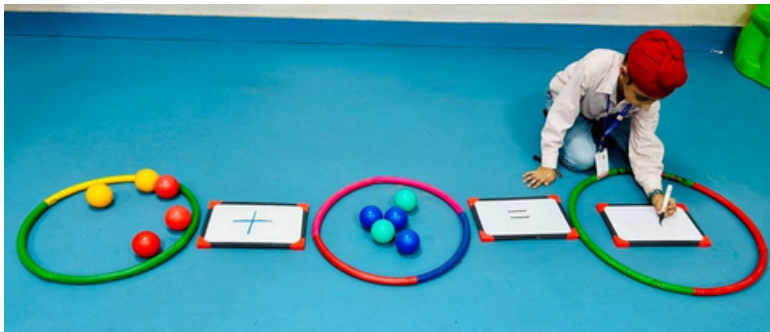
To make learning exciting, educators conducted interactive activities like "Do the Action" game in which picture cards were given to the children, they identified and acted out the action words.

The young learners thoroughly enjoyed learning addition in a joyful and experiential way.



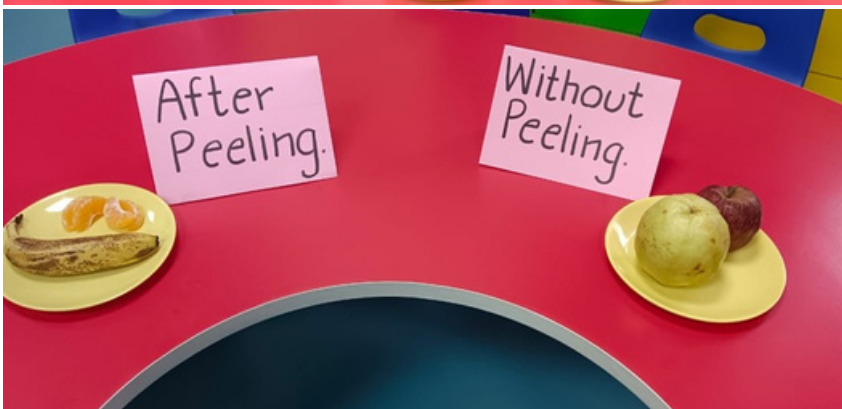
# Tree Plantation Activity

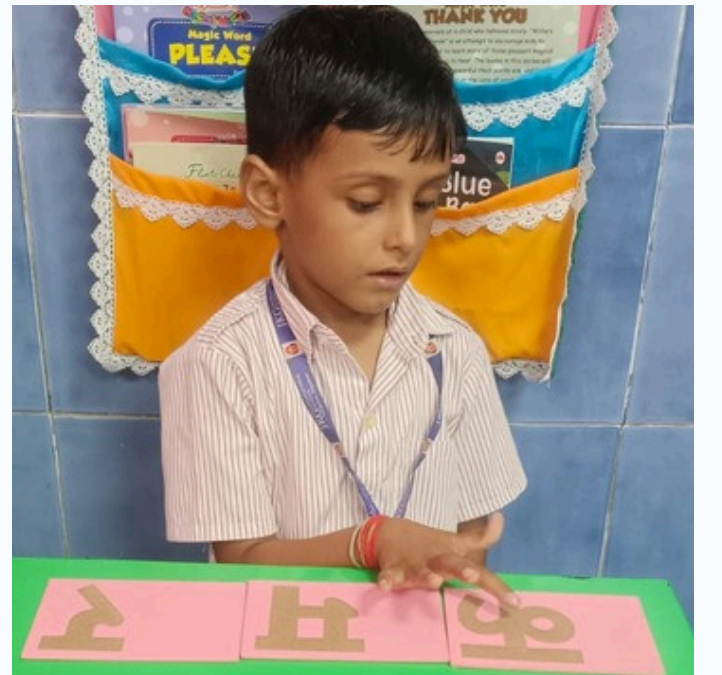
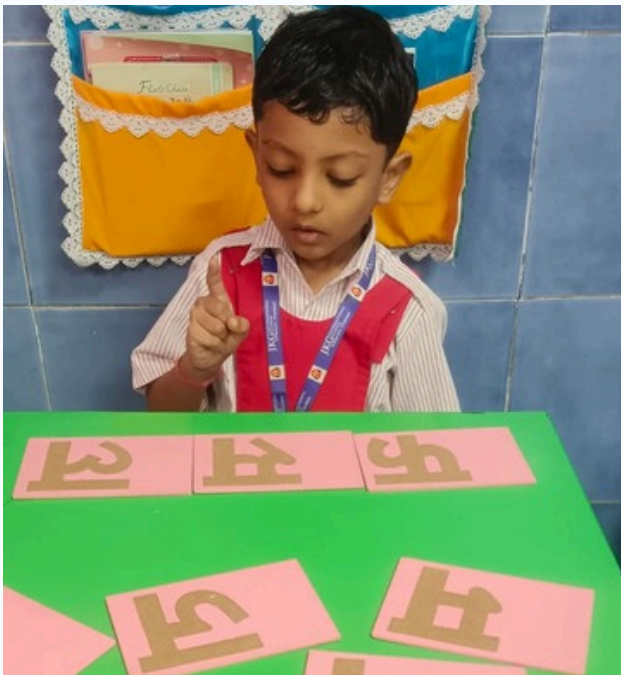

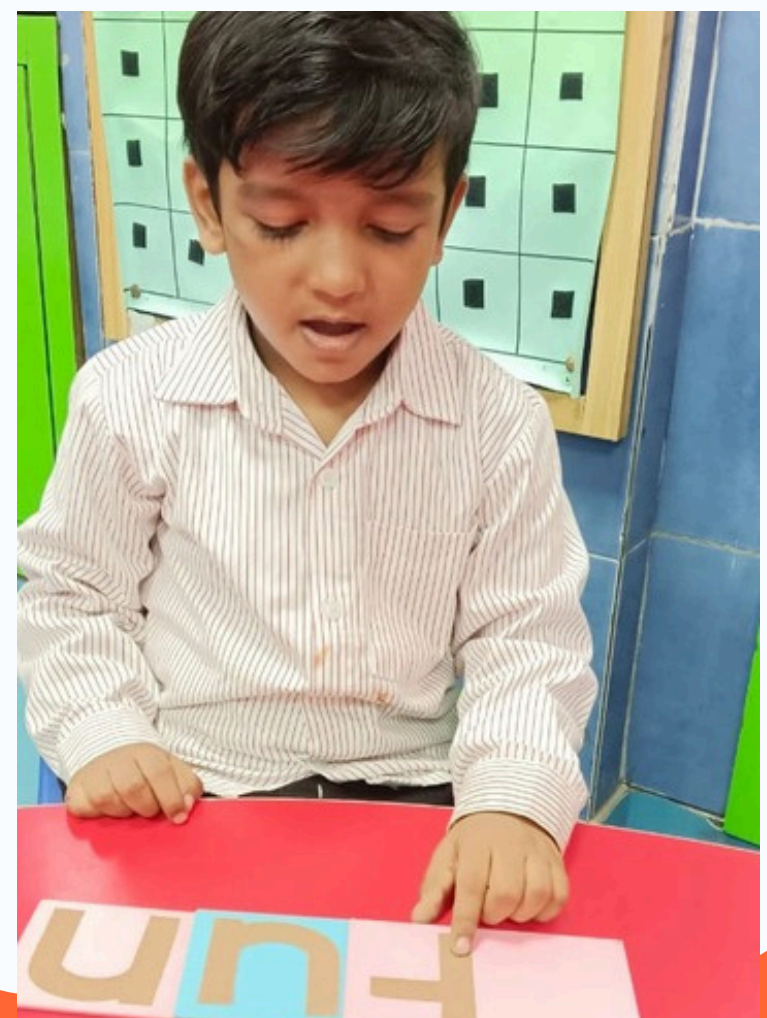


# Learning New Words through Play

## *Family Words with Flashcards!*

*(-ig, -ug, -in)*

Our young readers were introduced to the -ig, -ug, -un word family as part of their early literacy journey. Using flashcards, children explored simple and fun words like Big, Dig, Fig, Pig, mug, hug, fun. Each child took turns picking a flashcard, sounding out the word, and reading it aloud with confidence. This engaging activity helped strengthen their phonics skills, word recognition, and pronunciation—all while building excitement for reading!



# Letter Y

Teaching about Letter-Y to little our little sunshines is important as it helps them to identify and recognize letter and its sound and build early reading skills. Learning Y also improves vocabulary by introducing words like yarn, yellow, yak, yogurt, etc. It strengthens phonetic awareness and makes language learning fun.

Our little explorers used a Yarn for making a Yarn Painting with Yellow colour and enjoyed a lot.



# CONCEPT OF PET, DOMESTIC WILD ANIMALS

## PET ANIMALS

Teaching about Pet Animals helps nursery learners develop love, care, and empathy for living beings. It introduces them to responsibility, observation, and basic animal knowledge. Through the pet animal face puzzle activity, children enhanced problem-solving, concentration, and fine motor skills while joyfully arranging pieces to form pet faces. This playful method made learning engaging, interactive, and meaningful.



# MOO-MOO COW (Domestic Animals)

Our little ones learnt about Domestic Animals with an activity where they took care of Cow by feeding and milking her. With such hands-on activity they learn kindness, patience and respect for animals. Such experience makes learning joyful while nurturing empathy and awareness about the role of domestic animals in human life. It also makes learning enjoyable for our little explorers through real life connections.

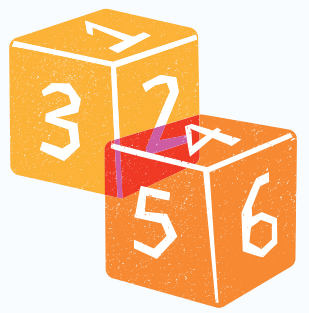


# LETTER- Z FOR ZEBRA: A WILD ANIMAL

Teaching Wild Animals to little munchkins builds awareness about nature, animal life, and the need to care for them. It sparks curiosity and develops observation skills.

In an activity, our little explorers used rice and black lentils to complete body and create stripes of 'Z'- Zebra. They not only learned about the Wild Animal but also about Letter- Z along with Zebra's unique pattern. They also improved fine motor skills, concentration, and creativity. This hands-on experience connected learning with fun, making concepts about Wild Animals integrated with English letter- Z, more engaging, memorable, and meaningful.





# "CONCEPT OF NUMBER 8"



Teaching number 8 to little explorers builds early math sense, sharpens counting, and sparks pattern recognition. Its round loops enhance fine motor skills while linking fun with learning.

In an activity, our little ones decorated an octopus by counting and beading 8 colorful beads onto its each arm out of eight arms. This hands-on task not only reinforced the concept of number 8 but also improved eye-hand coordination, focus, and creativity among our tiny tots making learning more fun. Our munchkins joyfully understood that each arm represents one count, making math exciting and meaningful through play.

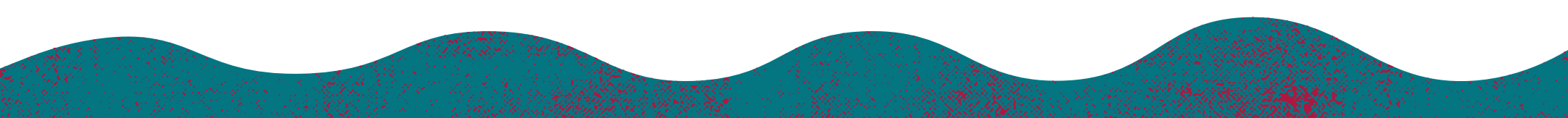

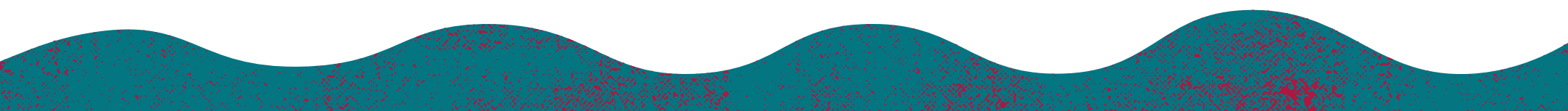
