Welcome to School

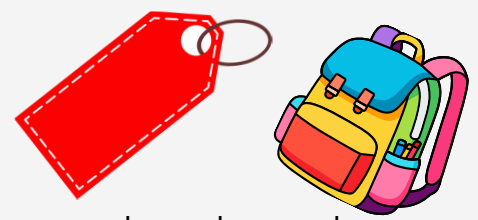
A Joyful New Beginning!

Baisakhi Celebration – Harvest of Joy

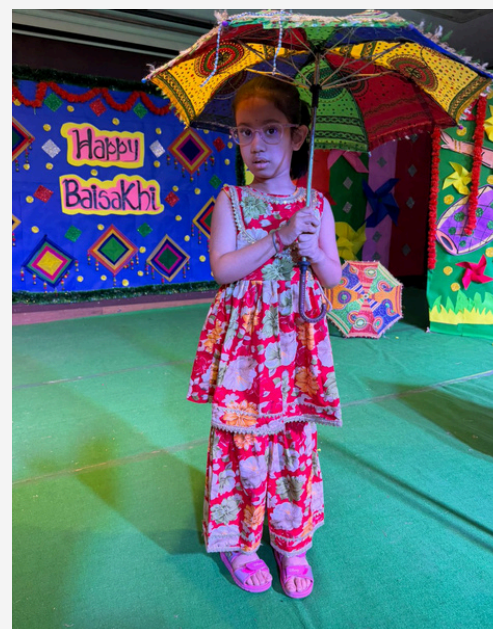

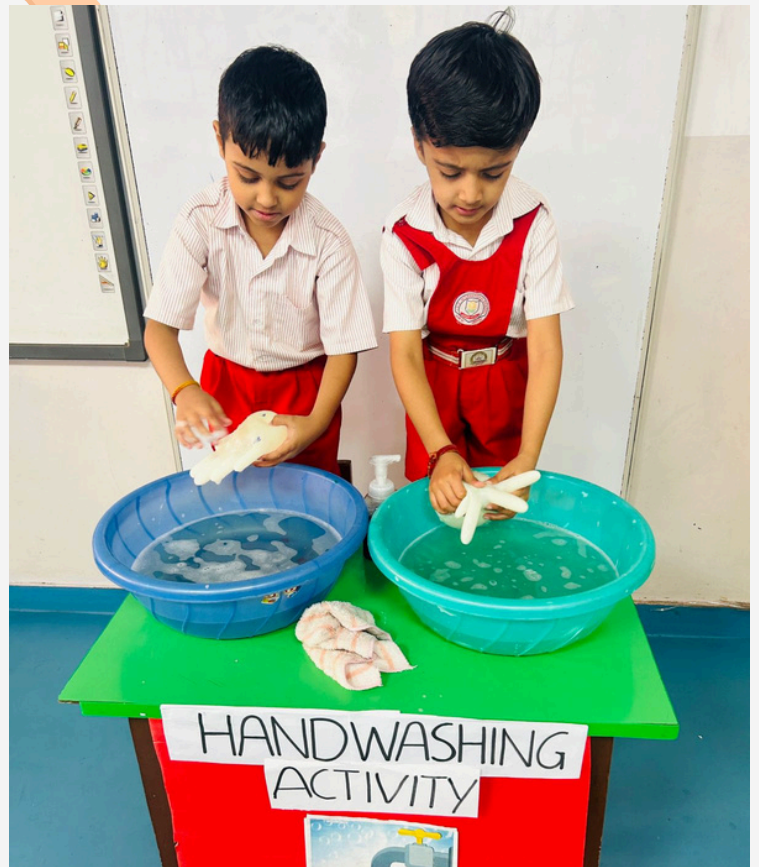


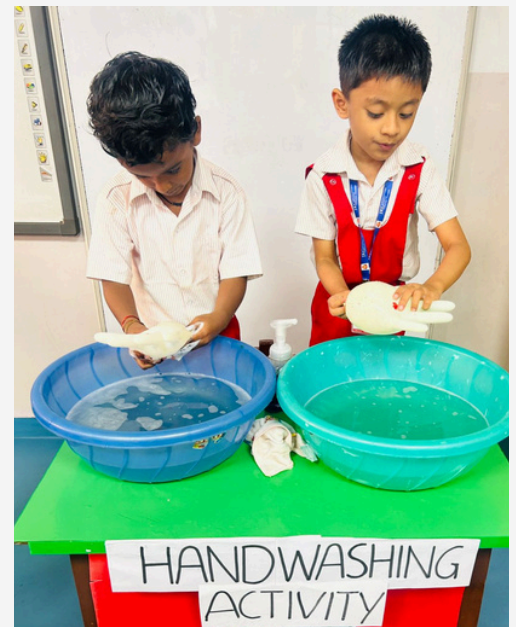
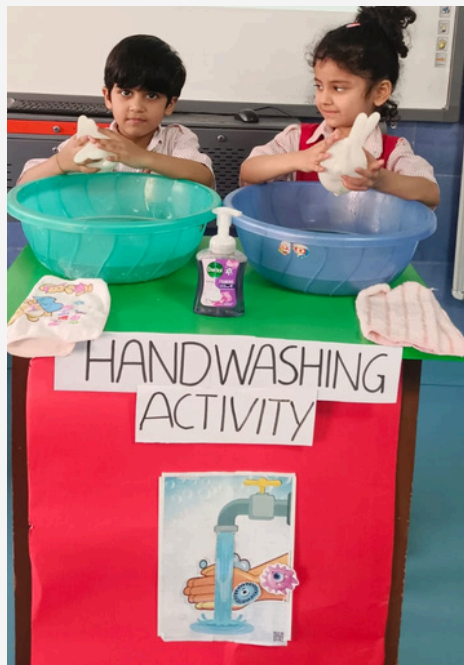
Germs Activity

Keeping our nails clean and short is a crucial part of personal hygiene. By learning how to trim the nails by a class demo, students got an idea of keeping their nails clean and short.



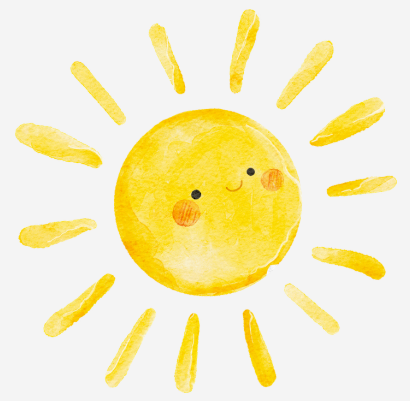
Hair care

Creative Learning in Action

Our little learners of Creative Hands actively engaged in thoughtfully designed activities—Disposable Cups Pyramid and Scribbling—that blended fun with foundational skill-building.

Through the Cups Pyramid, children developed balancing, hand-eye coordination, and gross motor skills.

In the Scribbling Activity, students explored creativity and expression, enhancing fine motor control and social interaction. These hands-on experiences supported holistic development and made learning both joyful and impactful.



Dip & Squeeze

Filled with curiosity, laughter, and joyful learning, the activity made every child an active explorer in the world of animals.





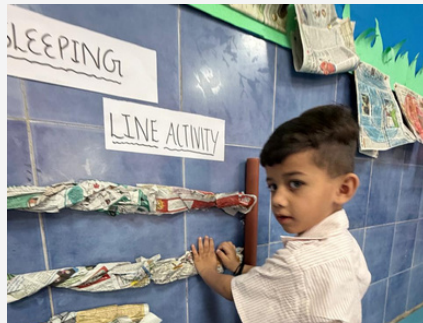
"Concept of Lines "

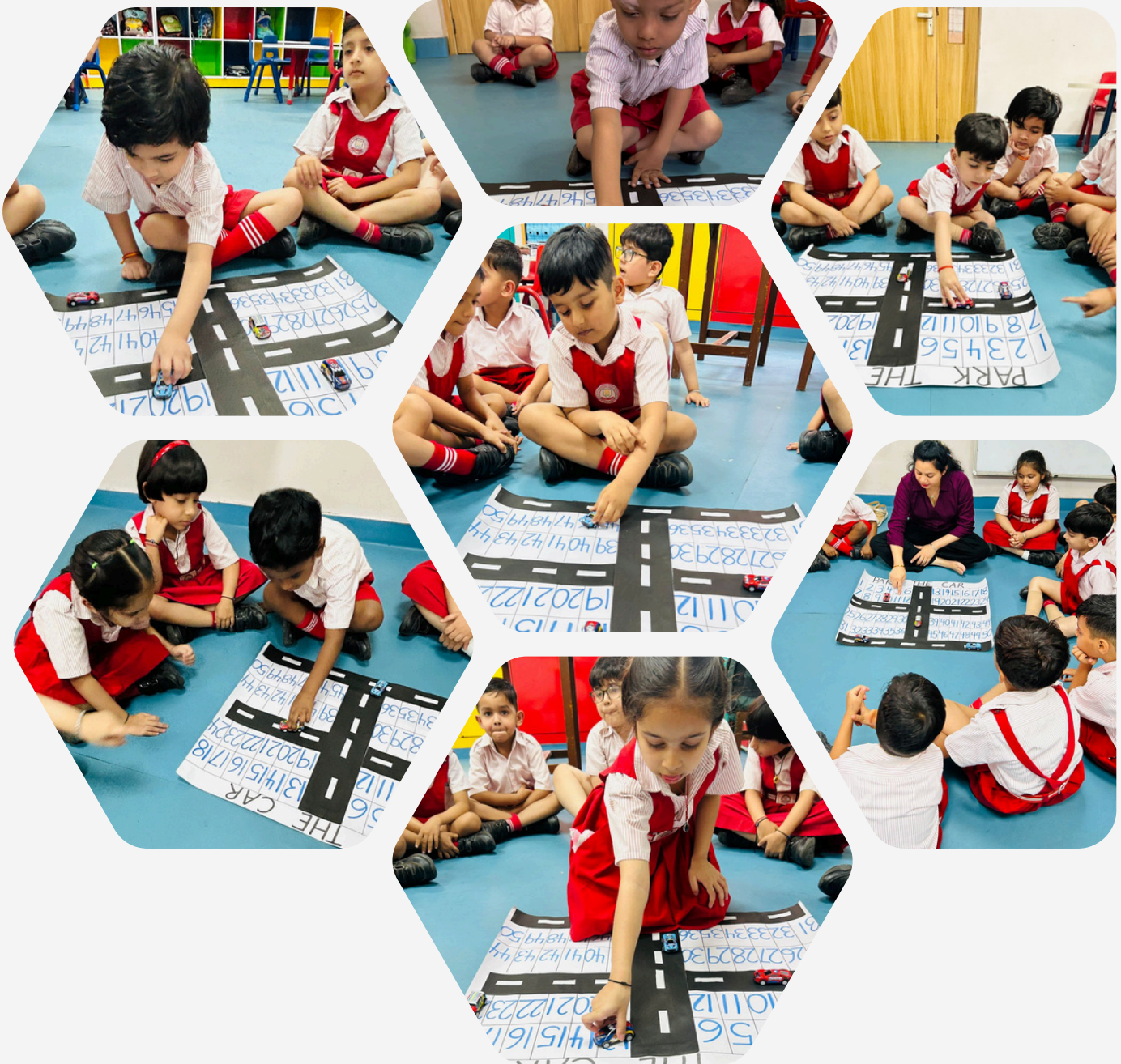


Exploring the Concepts of Pre- Math

This engaging activity strengthened number sequencing skills while making learning interactive and enjoyable.

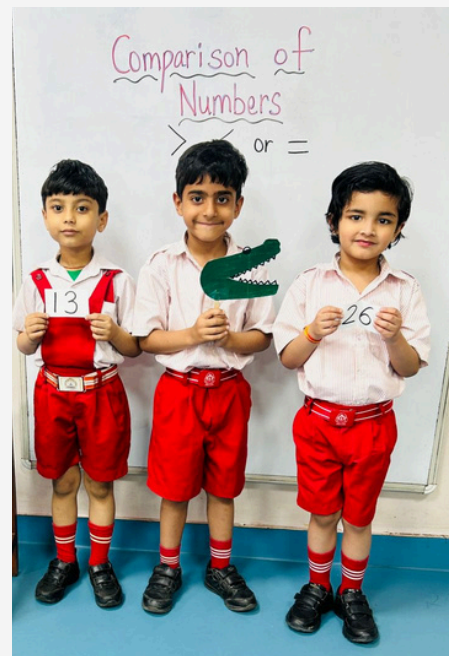
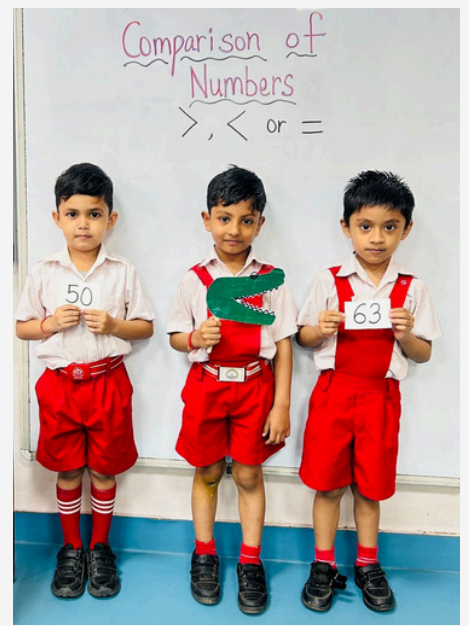
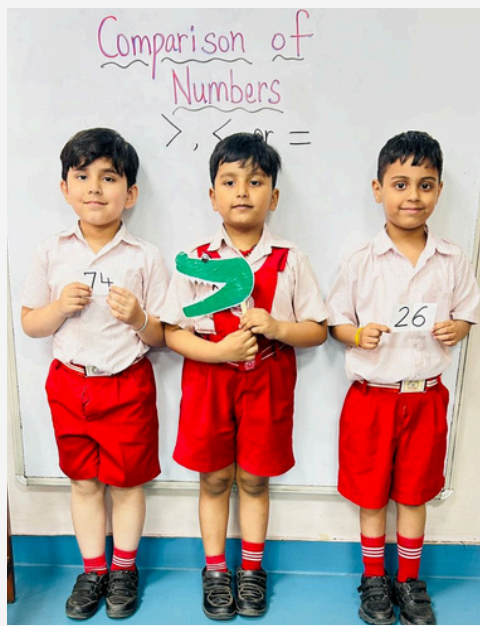
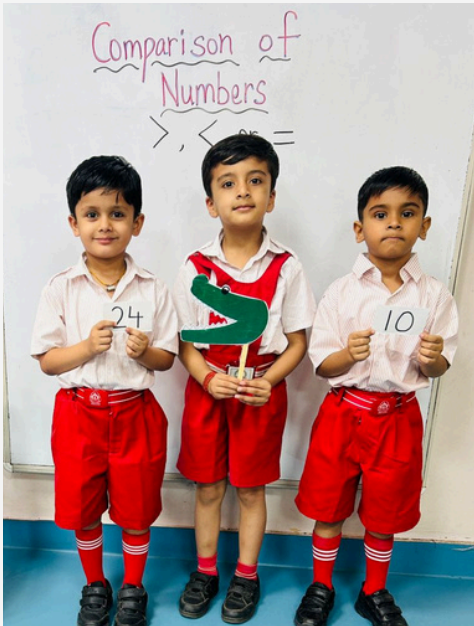


Comparing Numbers

One is Fun!

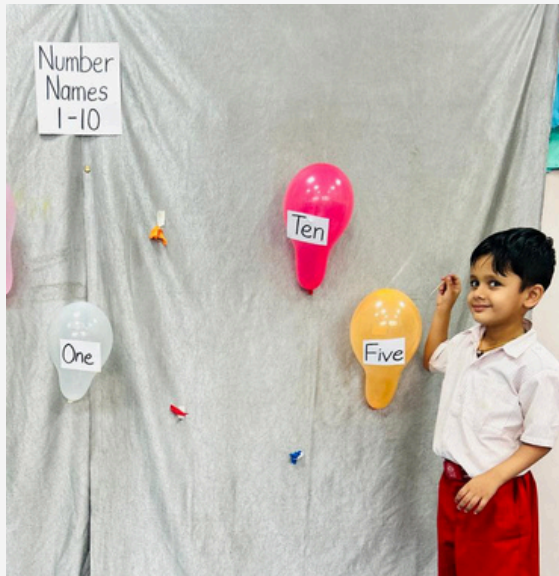
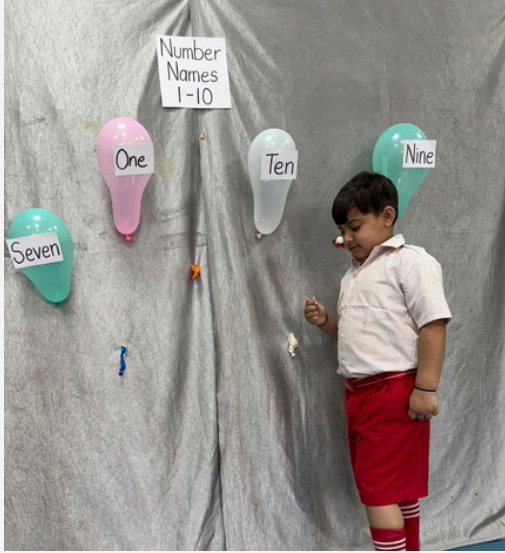
Learners joyfully explored the concept of Number 1 through an engaging hands-on activity. The fun-filled experience helped them recognise and understand the number with excitement and confidence.

Early Literacy Fun

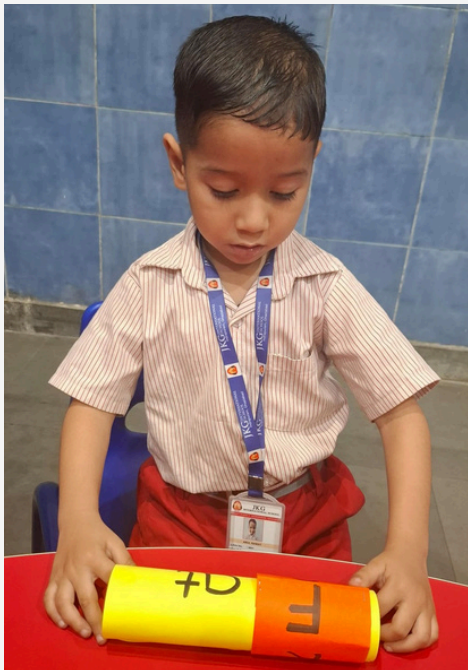
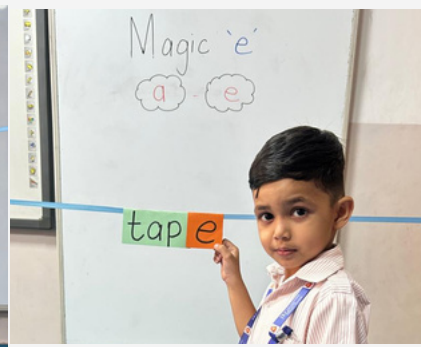

Learning New Words through Play

To introduce “family words” (-at.), “Magic e” words (a-e, i-e) in an engaging way, learners are encouraged to interact with picture-based activities. This method not only supports early reading development but also fosters word recognition through playful learning. Reading the words aloud after matching, further reinforces pronunciation and confidence in young readers.

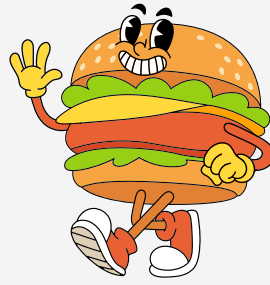
Two Languages. One Fun Learning!

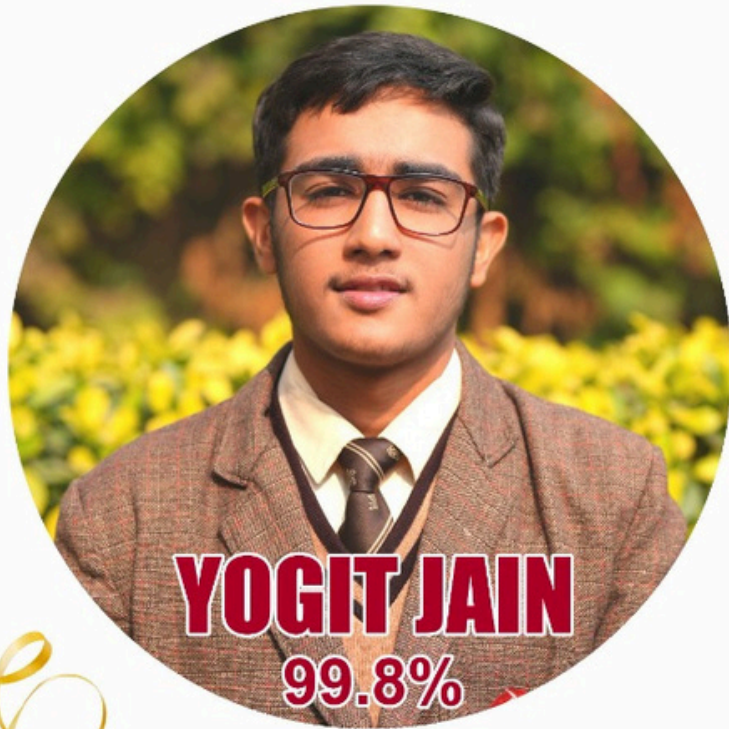
